
OAKLANDS Community Profile



Oaklands is an expansive and primarily residential neighbourhood in the NE corner of Victoria, bounded by North Dairy, Shelbourne, Haultain, and Cook Streets. The majority of development occurred between WWI and WWII, and before this, vast sections of the area west of Bowker Creek and the Hillside Shopping Centre area were farmland. There were areas of swampland along Haultain Street.










Within the City of Victoria, Oaklands, North Jubilee, and Rockland were the only neighbourhood's to have a negative growth in population.






Oaklands had a 7% increase in family income from 2000 to 2005. The city wide average is \$55,591, with a range from \$35,571 in Downtown Victoria to \$82,213 in Rocklands.

Oaklands has a higher percentage of owners than Victoria's average (40%) and less renters than Victoria's average (60%). The average rent in Oaklands is \$832.50, which is slightly higher than the provincial average (\$828).

The total number of housing units in Oaklands increased from 2,850 (2001) to 2,995 (2006). This 5% change was average to the City of Victoria. Oaklands has the second highest number of single detached houses.

Twenty four percent of Oakland residents walk, ride their bike, or take the bus to work while 54% drive. The City of Victoria average for driving is 47%. James Bay has the highest amount of cyclist commuters at 29%. The neighbourhood has six bus routes (#4, 22, 24, 25, 27, and 28) and four bicycle ways.


